COUNCILOR FRISOLI

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has already developed a Neighborhood Stabilization Program in conjunction with its UDAG plans for the Lechmere/East Cambridge area; and

WHEREAS: Significant development is also planned for Harvard Square at Parcel 1B, Kendall Square under the auspices of the C.R.A., Central Square through the CARD program and the Alewife Brook area under the City's Urban Design initiative; and

WHEREAS: It can be expected that the surrounding neighborhoods of these development centers will also require protection as a result of projected construction activities; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Community Development Department to develop Neighborhood Stabilization plans for the neighborhoods surrounding these development centers whereby a percentage of the proceeds from new taxes generated as a result of development is used to fund the stabilization activities; and be it further

ORDERED: That these programs are designed and implemented with the advice of the neighborhoods and planning teams, said planning teams to ultimately administer the programs.
