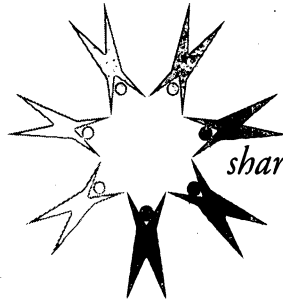

RE: Awaiting Report #51, dated 7/31/95 regarding offering meaningful daily resident discount on green fees

In response to Council Order Number 51, dated 7/31/95 regarding a Report on offering a meaningful daily resident discount on greens fees, the following is presented for your review.

A reduced daily greens from \$14.00 to \$10.00 for Cambridge juniors and seniors was initiated for the 1995 season. In order to reduce the daily fee for other Cambridge residents, the proposal would have to be reviewed with the Fresh Pond Golf Course Access Committee which was established in 1993 at the request of the City Council. The Access Committee, which is comprised of Cambridge residents, will be meeting within the next three months to review proposed fee schedules and golf course policies and procedures for the coming season and their recommendations will be forwarded to the City Manager.

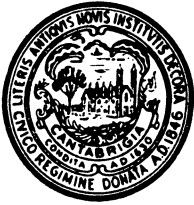

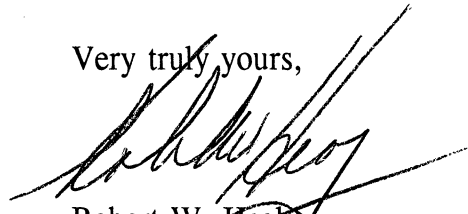
