Pearl (Nelson) Gilsdorf of Cambridge died after a lengthy illness on June 14 at the Palliative Care Center in Boston. She was 85.

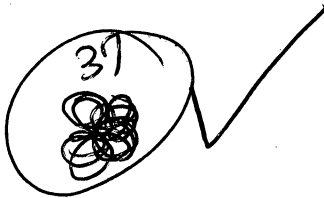
Gilsdorf was originally from St. Louis. She was a nurse for the school system.
