WHEREAS:

At the time of her entry into the Municipal Service said employee had no right to enter the retirement system of the City of Cambridge and is not entitled to any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by M. Madeline Vinicomb an annuity be granted to said employee of \$2,000.00 per year.




