- WHEREAS: Auburn Court represents a critically important newly constructed rental housing development for the City of Cambridge and the Cambridgeport neighborhood. It is being developed by Homeowner's Rehab, Inc., a local nonprofit with over 25 years experience in Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: When completed, it will include 137 units of mixed income housing (of which 91 are affordable) and a park to be used by residents of both Auburn Court and the neighborhood; and
- WHEREAS: Phase I of Auburn Court consisting of 77 units was completed in 1996; and
- WHEREAS: On October 24, 2000 at 2:00 PM a celebration will be held for the addition of these units of Auburn Court Phase II now approaching completion. The project consists of 60 units; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council thank all who have helped to make the creation of these homes a reality; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Homeowner's Rehab, Inc. on behalf of the entire City Council
