COUNCILLOR DANEHY

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to review the departmental budget for Fiscal Year 81-82 to determine whether or not any budget surplus exists in the Cambridge Police Department and further determine if any outages exist in the salary account for all ranks, with particular emphasis on the rank of Sergeant; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to include in his review the feasibility of appointing more than one Sergeant and if this is a possibility, the date on which said appointment would be made and further, whether or not said appointments would be made on the order of their finish on the Civil Service List; and be it further

ORDERED: That if there is any intention to skip anybody on the eligibility list that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report his findings back to this City Council within one week.
