Our investigation found that on November 1, 1979, the City of Cambridge received approval of its request to restrict Heavy Truck Traffic on Blanchard Road from Concord Avenue north to the Belmont Town Line. The signing has been checked and found to be correctly installed.

I, therefore recommend that the Cambridge Police enforce the existing truck restriction along this section of Blanchard Road.

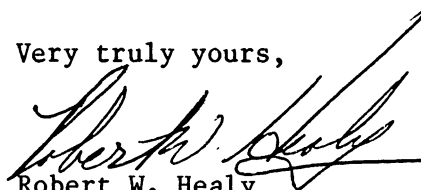
