Subject City Council Order #19 of Feb. 28, 1977, "Handicapped Person" Sign

I have made a study as to the feasibility of installing a "Handicapped Person" sign at 41 Line Street and find that this area is now posted "No Parking Tow Away". These signs were installed to allow emergency vehicles to pass through Line Street and to allow anyone to park there would definitely create a serious hazard to emergency vehicles as well as to rubbish trucks trying to make their pickups.

I will try to locate these signs somewhere close by but this area is so congested there is not too much legal parking available on-street. This parking problem is compounded by the fact that the even numbered side of Line Street is located in the City of Somerville and I cannot control it.

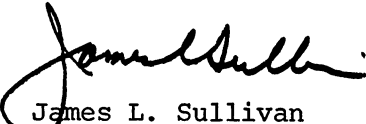
