To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$159,960.00 in the Grant Fund from the Department of Education through its Bureau of Nutrition Agency to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$6,000.00 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$153,960.00. The Summer food Service Program (SFSP) will provide a continuous meal service during the Summer months to low income children participating in Cambridge Summer Programs. Cambridge programs provide summer activities to children 18 years of age and younger who are eligible to participate if 50% or more of their enrollment is documented as low income. In addition, several sites were designated as "area eligible" by the state and will be allowed to serve all children in the neighborhood who want to drop-in for meals.
