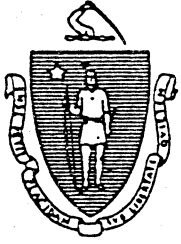

IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETY-Three

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO EXEMPT CERTAIN INCOME PRODUCING ASSETS FROM THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO AN ELDERLY ABATEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. When applying the criteria for abatement eligibility under M.G.L., Chapter 59, Section 5, Clause Forty-first C, the City of Cambridge is hereby authorized to exempt the income producing assets of an elderly person from the calculation of the maximum asset requirements thereunder, so long as the qualifying amount of gross receipts is otherwise met under the terms of the said State Statute.

RE: ADDITIONAL HOME RULE PETITION FOR POSSIBLE REILING

Attached is a copy of the home rule petition on the eligibility requirements for elderly abatements for property taxes which the City Council may wish to refile for the current legislative session. The City Council initially adopted a home rule petition on the issue on March 1, 1993. As you may recall, the City Council voted technical amendments to the petition on October 18, 1993, and directed the City Clerk to refile the amended petition. Due to the date of refileing, at the time the petition was refiled, I believed it was being filed for the next legislative session. However, the bill was filed for the 1993 session and consequently died at the end of that session.
