- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Firefighter Herbert A. Martin has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Martin was first appointed to the department on February 8, 1948 at which time he was assigned to Engine Company 4 briefly serving there until he was transferred to Engine Company 2 on September 16, 1948, and
- WHEREAS:** He remained there until January 1, 1950 when he was transferred to Engine Company 1 and later that year to Rescue Company 1, and
- WHEREAS:** Firefighter Martin remained in this assignment until June 23, 1964 at which time he became an Aide to the Deputy Chief, a position he held until his retirement on June 19, 1977, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Firefighter Herbert A. Martin for his dedication to duty for a total of 29 years and to further extend to him our best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
