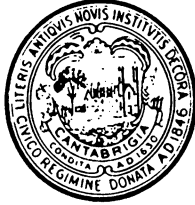

RE: Vendors Licensing for the Cambridge River Festival

The Cambridge Arts Council requests a single vendors license for the sale of artwork, crafts, and refreshments at neighborhood festivals held on public ways during the Cambridge River Festival, 15-21 May 1977.

Exhibition and sales of the work of over 100 artists will occur at several times and locations during the festival week. The Arts Council is reviewing the work of all artists and artisans wishing to sell their work; and is placing them at neighborhood festival sites at the request of community coordinators. There will be no vending on MDC land at the river on 21 May.

Many of the neighborhood festivals will be held on private land; but some will be held in Inman and Central Squares, and on streets closed off for the festival event. A complete list of sites, dates, and times is attached.

Please advise us of additional information necessary to obtain a single license for that week. We want to simplify the procedure, both for the individual artists, and for City employees. Since the Cambridge River Festival opens on 15 May, we are requesting that this license be granted at the 9 May 1977 City Council Meeting. Thank you.
