Subject Council Order No. 1 - (1/11/82) re: Hydrant at Chester St/Mass. Ave.

Pursuant to your request for information pertaining to the removal of this hydrant, please be advised that the Water Dept. had not been notified of this situation prior to receiving the Council Agenda on Monday Jan. 11. The Water Dept. Hydrant Maintenance crew was then sent to Chester St.; and it determined that the hydrant had been knocked over by a motor vehicle, and that the hydrant top section had been taken away by person (s) unknown.

The Water Dept. immediately notified the Cambridge Fire Alarm of this condition and informed it that work on replacing the hydrant would start on Tuesday, January 12. This work was completed on Wednesday, January 13, at which time the Water Dept. reported to Fire Alarm that the hydrant was back in service.

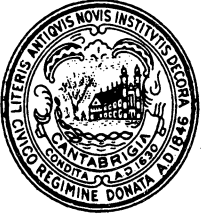
