- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works, the Superintendent of the Water Department and any other appropriate departments to investigate why there was such excessive water retention after last week's rain storm in the area of Sixth Street between Hurley Street and Charles Street; causing severe flooding in many homes within the area; and be it further
- ORDERED: That said investigation include a determination as to whether or not damage caused by this storm was an "act of God" or due to the ineffective operation of the flood gate operated by the Metropolitan District Commission.
