To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for \$693,900 to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Extraordinary Expenditures account to continue to provide funds for the HOME Program which will be used for the rehabilitation and construction of affordable housing units. The selection of projects will be based on the City's Consolidated Plan. The affordable housing units to be developed include acquisition/moderate rehabilitation, substantial rehabilitation, or new construction for very low and low income families or individuals who require social service support.
