It would also be very foolhardy at this point to indiscriminately sell our valuable assets.

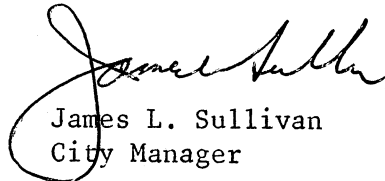
