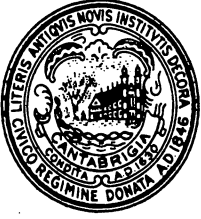


To the Honorable, the City Council:

In 1972 the City of Cambridge received a grant in the sum of \$5,000 from the Ford Foundation for the Cambridge Conservation Commission for a public education program to articulate the views of open space interests in the community as decisions are made regarding the future development of the Cambridge Dump. In order to receive this grant it was necessary for the City to match the funds which were provided in the Capital Improvements Account.

The Conservation Commission now advises this office that it has need for this \$5,000 from the Capital Improvements Account in order to cover expenses incurred in connection with this study. The City has expended in favor of the Conservation Commission from the Capital Improvements Account \$761.00. It is therefore necessary that the balance of \$4,239.00 be appropriated to the Conservation Commission; said sum to be by transfer of available funds in the Capital Improvements Account.
