IN CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS:

Implementing the regulations of the Community Development Block Grant Program (Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974) requires annual adoption by the City Council of a resolution to accomplish the following:

1. Direct that a Block Grant application be filed for funding;
2. Direct the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development acting for the City Manager, to file said application, make amendments as required and execute related contracts; and
3. Direct that the Federal Government be notified that Cambridge will comply with all Block Grant Program assurances and understandings required by law and administrative regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE;

That the fulfillment of the requirements of the foregoing paragraph by the City Manager or the Assistant City Manager for Community Development is authorized hereby and, in addition, specifically that the City Manager or Assistant City Manager for Community Development file an application for Federal Block Grant entitlement funds available to Cambridge in Fiscal Year 1993 as provided by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended;

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE;

That said application be filed with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development on or before June 2, 1992, for the required thirty (30) day review.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached resolution authorizes and directs the City Manager to apply for and administer the Fiscal Year 1993 CDBG funds available to Cambridge under the U.S. Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended.

The language of the resolution is the same as enacted by the City Council annually for the past sixteen years. The resolution is required as part of the CDBG application, which must be filed Tuesday, June 2nd.

Through its passage of the City's Fiscal Year 1993 budget on May 18th, the City Council concurrently approved the City Manager's CDBG budget as it appears in the application to be submitted June 2nd. This is because our CDBG funds are allocated and spent as part of the City budget.

The resolution is presented for enactment at the June 1st City Council meeting, since this is the first to be held since passage of the budget.
