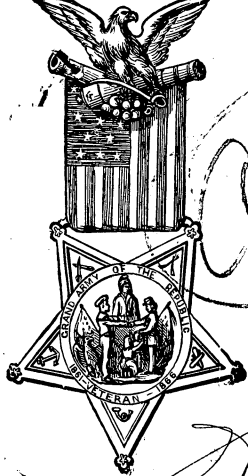

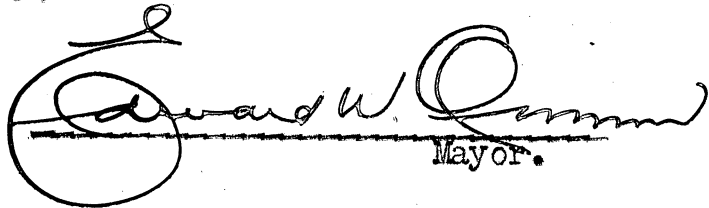
Honorable the City Council of the
