- WHEREAS: Henry was born in Somerville, attended local schools and later graduated from Tufts University and after graduation served his country well during World War I as a member of the United States Army; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to David F. Shea and to the entire Shea family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
