the first Tuesday of September, in the
year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred
and sixty-two

The inhabitants of Cambridge, in said County, by their petitions to
said Commissioners - among other matters - pray (1) that Massachusetts
Avenue, Munroe Street, Holsworthy Street, and Quincy Street, in said
Cambridge, may be specifically repaired; and (2) that Pleasant Street,
Brattle Street, Vassal Lane, Howard Street, Sacramento Street, Avon Street,
Bowdoin Street, Cameron Avenue, Plympton Street, Winter Street, Ellsworth
Avenue, Jay Street, Carver Street, Middlesex Street, and Garden Street,
from Taylor Square to Walden Street, in said Cambridge, may be specifically
repaired.

The petition pertaining to (1) Massachusetts Avenue, Munroe Street,
Holsworthy Street, and Quincy Street was presented to the County Commissioners
at their meeting holden at Cambridge on the first Tuesday of June, A.D.,
1960; and the petition pertaining to (2) Pleasant Street, Brattle Street,
Vassal Lane, Howard Street, Sacramento Street, Avon Street, Bowdoin Street,
Cameron Avenue, Plympton Street, Winter Street, Ellsworth Avenue, Jay Street,
Carver Street, Middlesex Street, and Garden Street, from Taylor Square to
Walden Street, was presented to the County Commissioners at their meeting
holden at Lowell on the first Tuesday of September A.D., 1962; when and
where notices were ordered given to all persons and corporations interested
therein of the time and place when and where said Commissioners would meet

for the purpose of viewing the premises and hearing the parties as by their orders of notice on file and of record will more fully appear.

And in the matter of the petition pertaining to (1) Massachusetts Avenue, Munroe Street, Holsworthy Street, and Quincy Street, said Commissioners directed specific repairs on portions of said ways from time to time as appears of record - the last return relating to specific repairs being dated October 19, 1962; thence said petition has been continued to this time.

And in the matter of the petition pertaining to (2) Pleasant Street, Brattle Street, Vassal Lane, Howard Street, Sacramento Street, Avon Street, Bowdoin Street, Cameron Avenue, Plympton Street, Winter Street, Ellsworth Avenue, Jay Street, Carver Street, Middlesex Street, and Garden Street, from Taylor Square to Walden Street, at the time of said view and hearing, said specific repairs were adjudged of public convenience and necessity; thence said petition has been continued to this time.

And, said Commissioners having given notice as the law directs, and on petition pertaining to (2) specific repairs of Pleasant Street, Brattle Street, Vassal Lane, Howard Street, Sacramento Street, Avon Street, Bowdoin Street, Cameron Avenue, Plympton Street, Winter Street, Ellsworth Avenue, Jay Street, Carver Street, Middlesex Street, and Garden Street, from Taylor Square to Walden Street, met at Superior Court House in said Cambridge on the twenty-sixth day of October, in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-two, when and where the parties appeared, to wit, the petitioners by John J. Curry, City Manager, and Ralph J. Dunphy, Acting Commissioner of Public Works, and no parties appeared to object.

And now said Commissioners make return of their proceedings in the premises as appears herein.

The premises having been examined, and the parties fully heard, said Commissioners proceeded to direct repairs on portions of (1) Massachusetts

Avenue and (2) Pleasant Street, Brattle Street, Vassal Lane, Howard Street, Sacramento Street, Avon Street, Bowdoin Street, Cameron Avenue, Plympton Street, Winter Street, Ellsworth Avenue, Jay Street, Carver Street, Middlesex Street, in the manner following, for a distance of about 21,560 feet, to wit:

Massachusetts Avenue - Davenport Street to MTA Yard;

Pleasant Street - Massachusetts Avenue to Memorial Drive;

Brattle Street - Mason Street to Sparks Street;

Vassal Lane - Huron Avenue to Lakeview Avenue;

Howard Street - Kinnaird Street to Western Avenue;

Sacramento Street - Massachusetts Avenue to Somerville line;

Avon Street - Linnaean Street to Shepard Street;

Bowdoin Street - Martin Street to Linnaean Street;

Cameron Avenue - Massachusetts Avenue to Somerville line;

Plympton Street - Massachusetts Avenue to Memorial Drive;

Winter Street - Third Street to Fifth Street;

Ellsworth Avenue - Broadway to Cambridge Street;

Jay Street - Kinnaird Street to River Street;

Carver Street - Museum Street to Sacramento Street

Middlesex Street - Rindge Avenue to Pemberton Street;

or as far as the funds made available therefor by the State, County and City will carry such work, or if funds remain thereafter, for similar work beyond the aforesaid limits, if deemed advisable. Said ways shall be improved by constructing a Class I bituminous concrete, construction course surface, grading and otherwise improving the ways.

The proposed work shall be estimated and designed by the Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and a Memorandum of Agreement has been made between the City of Cambridge and the aforesaid Department

of Public Works. Copies of said Agreement and the encumbrance report of the Department of Public Works have been filed in the office of the said Commissioners.

All the work shall be done by methods approved by the aforesaid Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and as may be directed by the engineer of the said Department of Public Works directing such work therefor; shall conform to all standard and applicable requirements of said Department of Public Works for such work and materials.

The work shall begin forthwith and shall be completed, if practicable, on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1963.

The said City of Cambridge shall pay all damages, costs, and expenses which any party may by legal process obtain in consequence of this order for specific repairs.

And, whereas the estimated cost of said work is \$155,000., of which the Commonwealth has available \$77,500., and the City has available \$38,750.; now, therefore, said Commissioners direct that upon the completion of said work to the acceptance and satisfaction of said Commissioners and said Department of Public Works of the Commonwealth, the County shall pay to the said City of Cambridge one-fourth ($1/4$) of the cost of the work done, but not exceeding the sum of Thirty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$38,750.).

In this matter J. Paul Bienvenu of Chelmsford acted in place of William G. Andrew, County Commissioner and resident of the said City of Cambridge, by appointment under the provisions of Section 12, Chapter 34, General Laws.
