Voted that the free use of the Athletic grounds of Harvard College on Holmes Field and Jarvis Field, from July 2^d to September 22^d 1888, both days inclusive, be offered to the City of Cambridge for public play grounds, on condition that the City will make suitable provision without cost to the College for the proper use of the grounds and for their return to the College in as good condition as that in which they shall be when received by the City.
