To The Honorable, The City Council:

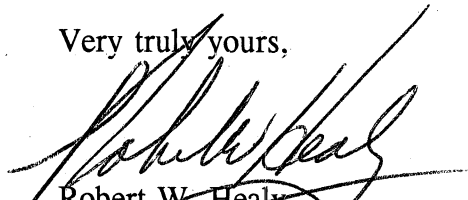
In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 31, regarding signage near schools, parks and playgrounds informing motorists of the presence of children, please be advised of the following:

The Traffic & Parking Department has surveyed the areas around the Harrington School and Donnelly Field for adequate signage. All school, school crossing and playground warning signs were found correctly posted, except for a playground sign on York Street which was reinstalled. These warning signs are those which are specified in the Manual on Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and are used in all 50 states. The Traffic Department is checking all school areas, parks and playgrounds to assure all warning signs are correctly posted. Any signs found missing will be reinstalled.

The Urban Forestry Division of the Public Works Department has inspected and trimmed the trees in the Berkshire Street neighborhood, particularly the trees near the school and playground.

Also, the Commanding Officers of both the Day and Night Patrol Sections of the Police Department have been directed to have the appropriate route or sector unit conduct selective enforcement of the speed limit on Berkshire Street.
