SUBJECT: Schedule of Trash and Litter Pickups at Corcoran Park

DATE: July 6, 1978

In conjunction with City Council Order #17 introduced by Councillor Frisoli, there has been a request made to this office through the City Clerk for the above indicated schedule.

Trash at Corcoran Park is picked up each Tuesday morning by the City's Department of Public Works. CHA owned barrels are provided to each tenant. The tenant is responsible for putting out the barrels and collecting after the trash pickup. One dumpster exists in the parking lot near the Management Office. This is serviced every Tuesday as well by a private disposal company at the CHA's expense.

The regularly assigned maintenance staff of Corcoran Park spend varying amounts of time each day picking up litter, depending upon the severity of the situation.

I trust this complies with the above-mentioned request.

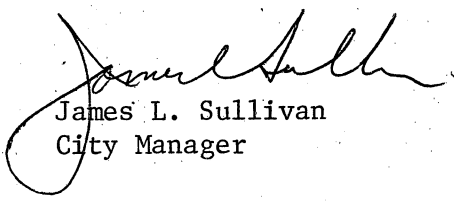
