WHEREAS: This is the simple yet critical mission of **THE TENTH ANNUAL AIDS PLEDGE WALK**, sponsored by the AIDS Action Committee of Massachusetts; and

WHEREAS: Sunday, June 4, 1995 at 9:00am on the Boston Common will mark the coalition of Cambridge Cares About AIDS, the Cambridge Hospital, employees of our City, with thousands of other concerned individuals and organizations across the Commonwealth to raise sorely needed funds to provide our community with adequate AIDS prevention, care and treatment; and

WHEREAS: The money raised by the **TENTH ANNUAL AIDS PLEDGE WALK** will directly benefit the Cambridge community, and in past years has gone to fund needed programs for people living with AIDS in our City; and

WHEREAS: No gift of time, or money, is too small, and every effort will be appreciated in this fight against AIDS; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council does hereby urge all Cambridge residents to participate in the **TENTH ANNUAL AIDS PLEDGE WALK**, sponsored by the AIDS Action Committee of Massachusetts, on Sunday, June 4, 1995 at 9:00am on the Boston Common; and be it further

RESOLVED: That residents of the City can contact the Mayor's Office, the Cambridge Hospital, or Cambridge Cares About AIDS to find out more about how they can help.

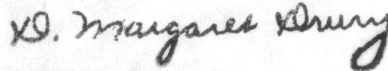
