- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of James F. Fitzgerald, a life long Cantabrigian and a former member of the Cambridge School Committee; and
- WHEREAS: James (Jimmy) Fitzgerald graduated from local public schools and continued his education receiving his law degree from Northeastern University Law School and upon graduation entered the private practice of law; and
- WHEREAS: At a relatively young age, Attorney Fitzgerald became politically active and ran for a seat on the Cambridge School Committee, winning eighteen consecutive elections, serving a total of thirty-six years of dedication to the children and people of Cambridge, immersing himself in the needs of schoolchildren, and while serving on the Committee, he was Chairman of the Sub-committee on Buildings and Grounds and served as Chairman and Treasurer of the Cambridge Library Board of Trustees; and
- WHEREAS: Along with his School Committee work, he was also, at one time, Register of Deeds for Middlesex County and a Technical Assistant and Advisor to the Suffolk County Land Court; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the Fitzgerald family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
