COUNCILLOR WYLIE

- ORDERED: That the City Electrician be and hereby is directed to hold in abeyance any further installation of sodium vapor lights in the City of Cambridge until this City Council is in receipt of a report from the City Manager after consultation with Planning Teams, Neighborhood Associations, Neighborhood Councils and all residents in the areas designated for these installations; and be it further
- ORDERED: That public hearings be held to which all residents of the affected neighborhoods be invited by posting in the affected areas and by advertisement in the local newspaper at least one week prior to the scheduled hearings; said hearings to be scheduled at a time convenient to assure the greatest attendance of all concerned; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Department of Public Health and the National Institute of Health be requested to investigate the impact of the sodium vapor lighting on all forms of vegetation and report their findings to this City Council prior to any further installations by the City Electrician; and that copies of this order be forwarded to Senator Edward Kennedy in order to enlist his assistance in the requested investigation, analysis and report by the National Institute of Health.
