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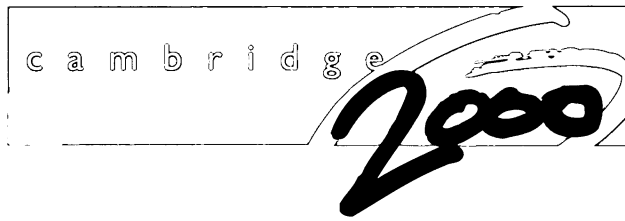

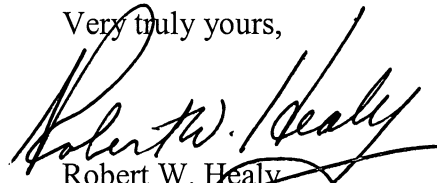
To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$345,000 to the Public Investment Fund Public Works Department Extraordinary Expenditure Account. This appropriation will be supported by Free Cash.

\$240,000 of these funds will cover renovation work required at 238 Broadway, including work related to sealing the building's envelope (roofing, masonry and windows), providing long-term facility maintenance, and creating expanded space for the functions of the Traffic, Parking and Transportation and Community Development Departments.

\$105,000 of these funds will be used for HVAC repairs and replacement, including the new Election Commission space at 51 Inman Street and renovations to the HVAC system in the building, Fire Department HVAC maintenance, and to address air quality concerns at 831 Massachusetts Avenue.
