by other pedlers.

I am a licensed, reputable pedler by the City of Cambridge
and holding a Mass. License #87301-A for Hawker and Pedler and
operating Andy's Place mobile kitchen outside M. I. T. at
77 Massachusetts Avenue and 50 Ames Street between 11:00 AM and
3:00 PM for almost a year paying \$25.00 monthly for the permit
required by the Department of Public Works to obstruct the street.

Recently other pedlers have come to Ames Street licensed
to park nearby for only ten minutes and have been ignoring time
limits.

The Department of Public Works is looking into the
situation and should they decide to rid Ames Street of all pedlers,
I would be subjected to unwarranted punishment.

Present city ordinance states a canteen truck cannot park
within two hundred yards of a store or restaurant. Could an addendum
be included to prevent canteen trucks from parking within two hundred
yards of each other.

Further, request consideration that I be allowed to remain
on Ames Street site on a rental basis.
