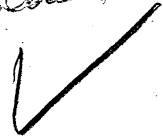

(Order to Construct Main Drain or Common Sewers,
General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, Chapter 83)

IN CITY COUNCIL

July 15, 1948.

WHEREAS:-

It is hereby adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that a main drain or common sewer should be laid out, made, constructed and maintained in certain private lands as follows:-

In Terminal Road a distance of five hundred sixty (560) feet it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the said main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and to report to this City Council after the completion of the work, the cost thereof and assessments shall be made as provided by law upon the abutting estates as follows:-

SUPPOSED OWNER

Joseph F. White - Assessors' Block Plan 265-B, Lot No. 23.

The aforesaid plan is on file in the office of the Assessors, City Hall, Cambridge, Mass.

A copy of this order certified by the City Clerk shall be recorded forthwith in the Middlesex South District Registry of Deeds.

IN CITY COUNCIL

July 15, 1948.

WHEREAS:-

It is adjudged by this City Council to be necessary for the public convenience and public health that an easement be taken in private lands for sewerage and water purposes, it is therefore hereby

ORDERED:-

That in the parcel of land hereinafter described an easement be and hereby is taken for sewerage and water purposes:-

Beginning at a point in the division line between land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and lot No. 23 on Assessors' Block Plan No. 265-B;-thence northwesterly along the southwesterly line of Terminal Road five hundred sixty-six (566.0) feet to a point in the northwesterly line of said lot No. 23;-thence northeasterly along said northwesterly line twenty-seven and five tenths (27.5) feet to a point;-thence southeasterly along the northeasterly line of Terminal Road by a line parallel to and distant twenty (20.0) feet northeasterly from the line previously described as being five hundred sixty-six (566.0) feet long, five hundred eighty-one and forty-six one hundredths (581.46) feet to a point in the aforementioned division line between land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and lot No. 23;-thence southwesterly along said division line twenty and two tenths (20.2) feet to the point of beginning. Containing 11,475 square feet. All the above mentioned dimensions and area are more or less.

SUPPOSED OWNER

Joseph F. White - Assessors' Block Plan 265-B, Lot No. 23.
