WHEREAS:-

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Susan D. McCusker, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That, under the provisions of Section 95A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Edward P. McCusker, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Susan D. McCusker, widow of Edward P. McCusker, of \$1200.00 per year.

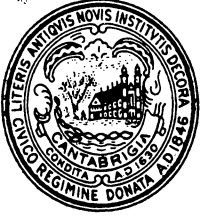


