WHEREAS: Under the current fiscal crisis, funding for this program and all supportive services programs is being threatened to be eliminated; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council go on record expressing its support for restoration of line item number 3722-9018 in the FY 91 state budget which will allow funding of the Work Force and all Supportive Services funding provided to the CHA; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a letter to each member of the Cambridge delegation of the House expressing its strong support for this program.
