REF: RESIDENTIAL CURB CUT at Wellington Harrington
Memorial Way on property at 20 Cornelius Way.

Enclosed with this letter is an application requesting a curb cut on the Wellington-Harrington Memorial Way. In our family we have 2 cars, plus our daughter comes and stays overnight often, and she has a car also. This creates quite a problem on Cornelius Way as parking is permitted only on one side of the street making it virtually impossible to find a parking space.

There is one other curb cut on the other end of Wellington-Harrington Way & James Way. We estimate the cut on our property at 20 Cornelius Way to be approximately 71 feet from the corner of Wellington-Harrington & Cornelius Way. There is now no parking allowed on Wellington-Harrington Way so in no way will we be taking spaces away from anyone. We feel with our car off the street it will create more spaces for our neighbors on Cornelius Way.

As lifelong residents of this City we do not think the request is unreasonable. Please let us know when we can expect this to take place; hopefully before the cold weather sets in.

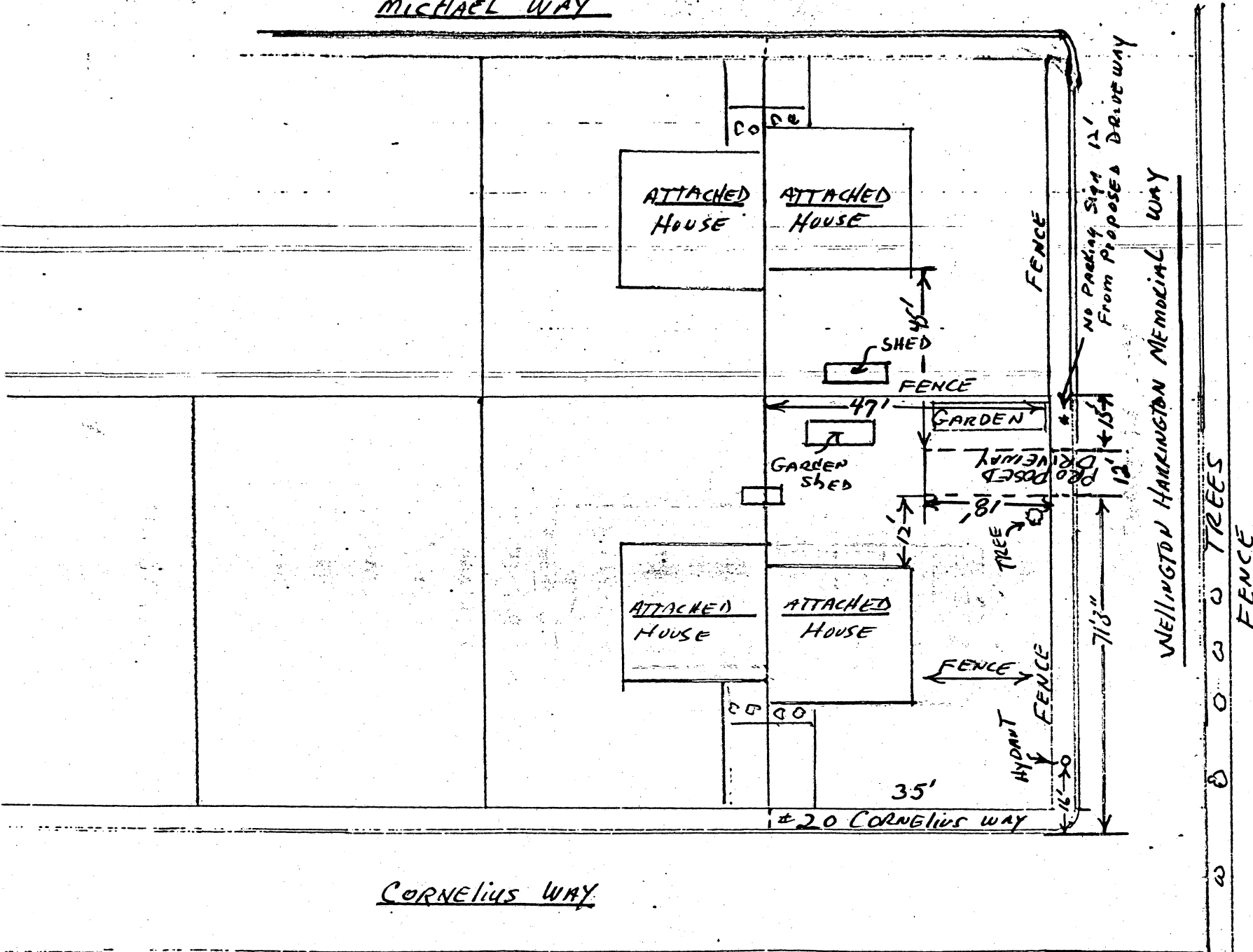

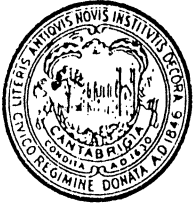
