In Board of Aldermen, Law. 25. 1882.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets, be authorized under the direction of the Committee on Roads and Bridges on the part of this Board, to furnish and set edgestones, and pave sidewalks on any portions of the public streets, where the abutters agree in writing to pay for all materials furnished, and to waive all claims for damages on account of any such change of grade as may be necessary in the work named. The expense therefor to be charged to the Appropriation for Street Department Paving.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized to lay cross-walks and pave gutters on the public streets of the city when the same is deemed expedient by the Committee aforesaid.

Such expense to be charged to the Appropriation for Street Department Paving.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized to grant permits to open the streets in accordance with Sections 14 and 15 of the ordinance relating to streets.
