ORDERED: That the proposed ordinance regulating the control of dogs be amended by adding a new section 4-7 entitled "Control of Dogs - Fresh Pond Reservation" which reads as follows:-

4-7. Control of Dogs - Fresh Pond Reservation.

Dogs may go unleashed on the Fresh Pond Reservation provided they have been trained to follow oral commands from their masters, except for the mowed, grassy areas, and be it further provided that the Water Board be instructed to issue Resident Sticker Permits to Cambridge residents only and to enforce said regulation immediately.
