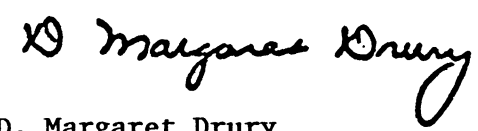

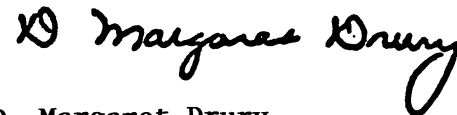

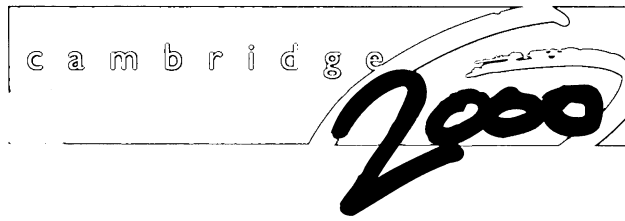

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of a grant for \$39,809 from the Executive Office of Communities and Development to the Grant Fund Human Services Salaries and Wages account (\$38,885), Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$724), and Travel and Training account (\$200) to provide funds under the Homeless Intercept Program to prevent homelessness by providing counseling for tenants and landlords, mediation for disputes between tenants and landlords, and housing search assistance for families facing eviction. These funds will be used to cover a portion of the salaries of the three caseworkers as well as program costs and training.
