That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the City Solicitor to prepare a written opinion specifying the legitimacy and legality, or lack thereof, of fundraising activities undertaken by members of the City Council as individuals, apart from the collegial Council entity, as a vehicle to sponsor or co-sponsor city events carried on by various city departments. This lone ranger approach to underwriting city events, with its potential for abuse, warrants close scrutiny; and be it further

ORDERED:

That the solicitor's opinion be provided to this Council by September 24, 1990 for review and due response from the Council, if such be judged as necessary.
