In Board of Aldermen, Jan 6. 1886.

Ordered,

That so much of the Mayor's inaugural address as relates to the construction of a new bridge across Charles River, between the cities of Boston and Cambridge, - be referred to a Joint Special Committee with authority to confer with a similar Committee of the City Council of the City of Boston, with reference to such action as ^{it} may be deemed expedient to take, under the provisions of Chapter 105 of the Legislative acts of this Commonwealth for the year 1882, - entitled "an act to authorize the cities of Boston and Cambridge to construct and maintain a bridge across Charles River."

Said Committee to consist of his Honor the Mayor and three members of this board with such as the Common Council may join; together with the City Solicitor and the City Engineer.

Send down for concurrence. Aldermen Allison, Cogan and Lombard being appointed in said Committee, on the part of this Board.
