I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$338,950.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries and Wages Account (\$179,571.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$150,739.00) and the Travel and Training Account (\$8,640.00) from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The Center for Substance Abuse Prevention of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has awarded this grant to the Cambridge Department of Human Services to act as the lead agency of the Cambridge Prevention Coalition. The purpose of this grant is to build a coalition of agencies, organizations and partnerships aimed at reducing alcohol, tobacco and other drug use, and to integrate substance abuse prevention into managed health care systems. Coalitions members include the Cambridge Substance Abuse Task Force, the Health of the City partnership and the Cambridge Hospital Community Health Network.
