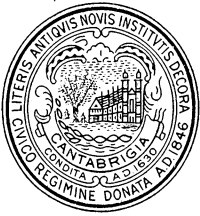
Dear Mr. Mayor,

At a recent meeting of the Rector, Wardens, and Vestry of St. Peter's Episcopal Church, Cambridge, it was voted to request the City Council, through the office of the mayor, for a change in the name of Vernon Street of which we are, at present, sole occupants.
