The Standing Committee on
Roads & Bridges
to which was referred the petition of
William A. Saunders & others, for a Brick
sidewalk on both sides of North Avenue, from
Harvard Square to the Fitchburg Rail-
Road Bridge —

The petition of James C. Davis
& others, that a Brick sidewalk be constructed
on one side of Broadway, from Olney Street to
its junction, with Main Street —

The petition of William H. Odiorne
& others that a brick sidewalk be constructed the
entire length of Harvard Street on its Northernly
side — having considered the same,
would respectfully report —

that to comply with the
prayers of the above petitioners would involve an
expense of about \$6000. — that in view of the limited
appropriation, & the very great expense attending the
construction of sidewalks on these long & wide Streets,
& in consideration of the fact that the City Construct

one last-year upon Main St. - It is now
constructing another upon Cambridge St.,
Your Committee recommend that the
above petitioners have leave to withdraw.
