
Dear Ms. Drury:

On December 18th, I attempted to renew our resident parking sticker at City Hall Annex, as I have done since this requirement was made. This year, however, the clerks have informed me that since F.B. Hubley & Co., Inc. is a business, and that the owner is not a Cambridge resident, we are no longer entitled to a sticker.

We have been in business since 1936, serving the Cambridge and Boston area as household liquidators and estate appraisors. If the City takes away our parking privileges we will be unable to continue the same level of service to the Cambridge community. Our customer base exists in these residential areas.

We are a corporation, existing as a single legal entity and pay our taxes diligently to the City. We should be entitled to the same level of service for our tax dollars as all other entities. There seems to be no benefit to the City in denying a resident sticker for our corporate vehicle.
