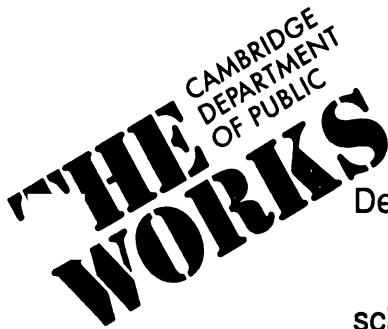




**SEWER SERVICE SEPARATION
CLIFTON, JACKSON, CLAY, MONTGOMERY,
REED, CEDAR AND HARVEY STREETS**

Dear Resident:

A sanitary, combined sewer, and storm water sewer project is scheduled to begin in your area in the near future. The completion of this project will solve many of the sewer and flooding problems experienced in the area.

The contractor has been given a total of nine months to complete the entire project. We do not expect the actual construction to take this amount of time. You may have short periods of time when you experience some inconvenience. However, the inconvenience should not be for long periods of time even under the worst of circumstances. A map is attached indicating the streets that work will take place on over the entire nine months. The contractor's schedule indicates they begin work on or about April 4, 1994. The areas that work will start on this date will include:

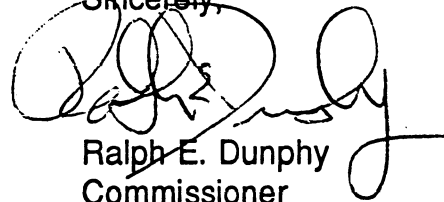
Montgomery Street from Rindge Avenue to Harvey Street

We will be closing the streets to through traffic only in the areas that are being worked on that day. Residents living in the area should not experience significant inconvenience. If we are going to be working directly in front of your house, the contractor will provide you with a notice 24 hours in advance. If you need your car that day, we request you move it out of the driveway before 7:00 AM the day the work is scheduled. You should be able to gain access to your driveway after 3:30 PM that day.

Projects of this type always bring inconvenience, change, noise, dust, and other problems. Our intentions are to work quickly and minimize any inconvenience to the residents in the area. We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to completing the project in a timely manner.
