Scudder, that the petitioner have permission to lay a flagging of North River Slates at his own expense upon the sidewalk next to his residence on ~~Brattle Street and Lowell Street~~, said flagging to be three feet wide on Brattle Street and two feet wide on Lowell Street, - provided said petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a written guarantee, satisfactory to the City Solicitor to save the City of Cambridge harmless from any liability for damages caused by his neglect at any time to put said flagging in proper repair within twenty-four hours of the reception of due written notification of ^{to} ~~the~~ dangerous condition, by the city authorities.
