

To the Honorable Board of Mayor and
Aldermen of the City of Cambridge -

David W. Leaver of Roxbury respectfully
represents that he is the owner of the estate situ-
ated on the corner formed by the junction of the
southeasterly line of Temple Street with the North-
easterly line of Main Street in Cambridgeport; -
that he contemplates making an improvement on said
estate by demolishing the present old building and
erecting a large and elegant one in its stead; -
He therefore prays your Honorable Board to estab-
lish and definitely fix the Northeasterly line of said
Main Street between Prospect Street and Union
Street, to the end that he may locate his contem-
plated building aright; so that the owners of
the adjoining estate and also the owner of the estate
on the westerly side of Temple Street and the northerly
side of Main Street may not erect buildings nearer
to Main Street than your Petitioner's. And he further
represents that in his opinion it would be for the benefit
of the City that said Northeasterly line of Main Street
~~should~~ between Prospect & Union Streets should be
fixed and established within a few inches of the
southeasterly fronts of the buildings of Mr Cutler, your
Petitioner and of Mr Pernick; and if you see fit so
to fix & establish said line, your Petitioner will ask no
damage

for the land taken from his estate for that purpose.

He respectfully asks as early action in the premises
as may comport with the convenience of your Hon. Board,
