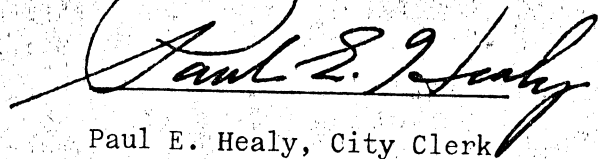

I have viewed the proposal of the Hyer Company, Inc. to operate a shuttle van between the Hyatt Regency Hotel and Logan Airport. After conferring with Mr. William Caron, the President of Hyer Company, it was decided that the routes proposed would create no serious problem as far as traffic is concerned. The size of the van would carry 11 to 15 persons and the frequency of the trips would be every hour if one van was used and every  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour if two vans were used. The van would load and unload on private property and would only use our main arteries for traveling with no pick-ups or drop-offs in between.

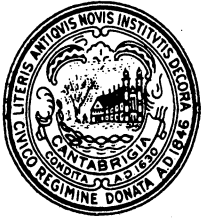
I, therefore recommend approval provided all outbound and return routes are the same.

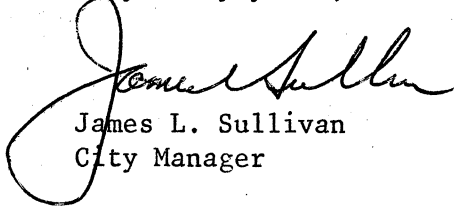

**The undersigned respectfully pray**

That Hyer Co. of 116 Hobbs Road, Princeton, Massachusetts be granted a license to operate common carrier motor vehicles in the city of Cambridge, with restrictive use, for the purpose of providing a shuttle service, seven days a week from 6 a.m. to 11:45 p.m., to and from the Logan Airport and downtown Boston for the patrons and guests of Hyatt Regency Cambridge over the routes hereafter set forth, and hereby agrees, under the penalty of Revocation of License, to comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations concerning the carrying and transporting of said patrons and guests by said motor vehicles pursuant to said license.

SHUTTLE ROUTES

Route 1: Shuttle van will exit Hyatt Regency onto Amesbury St., take a left on Amesbury St. to Vassar St., take right on Vassar St. across Mass. Avenue to Main St., turn right on Main St. and follow straight over Longfellow Bridge into Boston. Coming down bridge into the Rotary, turn left at the 2nd left in the circle into Charles St. Follow Charles St. onto Storrow Drive, continue on Storrow Drive up the ramp on lane marked Rt. 3 South Callahan Tunnel. Continue on Rt. 3 south following Callahan tunnel signs, take exit marked 1-A N/Callahan tunnel. Continue through the Callahan tunnel through the toll booth. Follow signs Rt. 1-A North, get off at Airport exit and Airport Road. Follow Airport Rd. straight to TWA Terminal, Eastern Airlines and World Airlines Terminals marked arriving and departing passengers. Follow Airport Road around heading back towards Boston, 1-A south through toll booth and into Summer Tunnel. Come out of tunnel, turn right up ramp out Rt. 3-N. Take exit marked Cambridge, Somerville, Back Bay, follow down the ramp staying right of Storrow Drive. Go around Rotary and turn right onto Rt. 28 N. past the Science Museum. Turn left under the underpass onto Cambridge St. Turn left onto 1st St. and follow straight over draw bridge and turn right up ramp and turn right onto Broadway St. Follow Broadway around Kendall Square Rotary and turn right onto Main St. Follow Main St. past the new Cambridge Center building. Turn left on Vassar St. and follow across Mass. Ave. past MIT Athletic fields to Amesbury St. Turn left on Amesbury St. and right into Hyatt Regency Cambridge from Circle entrance. Pick up and drop off new passengers.

Route 2: Shuttle van would exit Hyatt Regency Cambridge onto Amesbury Street. Take a left onto Amesbury St. and proceed North to Vassar St. Take a right on Vassar Street and proceed to Mass. Ave. Take a right on Mass. Ave. and proceed to Boylston St. Take a left on Boylston St. and proceed to the Prudential Center. At this point, we would drop off passengers and proceed on Boylston St. with the remaining passengers to Charles St. Take a left on Charles St. and proceed to Beacon St. We would take a right on Beacon St. and proceed to Bowdoin St. Then take a left on Bowdoin St. and proceed to Cambridge St. Take a right on Cambridge St. and proceed to Sudbury St. Take a left on Sudbury St. and proceed to Congress St. Take a right on Congress St. and proceed to North St. Take a left on North St. and drop off remaining passengers at North St. and Clinton St. Follow North St. to the on-ramp to the South East Expressway, Route 3-N. Exit at the Cambridge Somerville Storrow Drive Back Bay Exit and proceed down Storrow Drive Back Bay to Mass. Ave. exit. Exit at Mass. Ave. take a right on Mass. Ave. and proceed to Vassar St. in Cambridge. Take a left onto Vassar St. and proceed on Vassar St. to Amesbury St. Take a left onto Amesbury St. and enter the circle of the Hyatt Regency Cambridge.
