- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Jeremiah J. Mullane, a life long Cantabrigian, will soon retire from his position as Sexton of Saint John the Evangelist Church, North Cambridge, completing sixty-two years of dedicated service; and
- WHEREAS:** Jerry has virtually devoted his entire life to serving Saint John's, taking care of the entire complex at Saint John's, including the church, rectory, former high school and the grammar school; Jerry was the original "Mr. Clean" of the parish; and
- WHEREAS:** Jerry was also a regular and faithful member of the Knights of Columbus Council #269, as well as a member of the Saint John's Usher's Club and Holy Name Society and the infamous Barry's Corner Boys; and
- WHEREAS:** It should be noted that Jerry's love and devotion to Saint John's Parish was inherited from his mother, who in 1934 founded the school lunch program, which became a model for other schools throughout the area; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations and best wishes for continued good health and happiness to Jeremiah J. Mullane as he retires from his position at Saint John's and begins a life of retirement with his wife Rita, two daughters and grandson Michael; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Jerry on behalf of the entire City Council.
