- WHEREAS: Edward served his country with distinction during the Korean conflict as a member of the United States Navy from 1951 to 1954 where he was honorably discharged; and
- WHEREAS: Edward has long been active in Polish-American activities throughout the city and in particular in the functions and ceremonies at St. Hedwig's Church located on Otis Street; a job he performs with total sincerity and one which has brought him the tremendous respect of the Polish community; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation to Edward "Eddie" Butrym, as he completes his service with the City of Cambridge and to further extend to him every good wish for continued good health and happiness in all his future endeavors; and be it further
