- WHEREAS: There is a continuing use of Columbia Street by trucks despite the posting, two months ago, of signs prohibiting trucks; and
- WHEREAS: Complaints by residents to the City of Cambridge, police, and to the Traffic and Parking Department have brought no decline in truck traffic; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be respectfully requested to take appropriate measures to force trucks to use the designated truck routes; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be respectfully requested to advise the Cambridge Police Department that the City Council wants a vigorous, consistent enforcement of the restrictions on truck traffic.
