As Cambridgeport residents we are deeply concerned about the pattern of sexual assaults that have taken place in our neighborhood over the last two years. According to the *Cambridge Chronicle* the rape last week at Brookline and Allston Streets is now the fourth recent unsolved sexual assault in Cambridgeport.

**We would like to be assured that investigations into these crimes are being vigorously pursued until the perpetrators are caught and stopped.**

**We would like the City to take measures to increase safety in Cambridgeport, particularly of women at night.**

**These measures should include:**

- increased police presence in the area
- improved lighting, specifically related to open space and construction sites
- a public information campaign about personal safety, organized by the City, specifically geared towards those who use Central Square and its surrounding neighborhoods at night.

We look to our elected and appointed officials for clear and effective leadership at this time. We ask for your determined

commitment to allocate the necessary resources to solve these 'unsolved' crimes and in rebuilding a climate of trust and security in our community.
